Beginning at Meander Post on line between Sections
2 & 3. Thence run on Section line N 1/2 W 97ch to the left bank
of the Tuolumne River. Meander down Stream. Run N 81° W
12.87ch, S 88 3/4° W 16.46ch, S 81 1/4° W 7.00ch, S 77 1/4° W 4.00 to 1/4 Section
line. Thence run on 1/4 Section line S 1/4 E 5.77ch to U.S.
Meander line. Thence run on U.S. Meander line N 82 3/4°
E 40.25ch to the place of beginning.

Run by the true Meridian. Magnetic Variation 15° 30'
East.

April 18th 1859 and the instruction of the
Surveyor General.

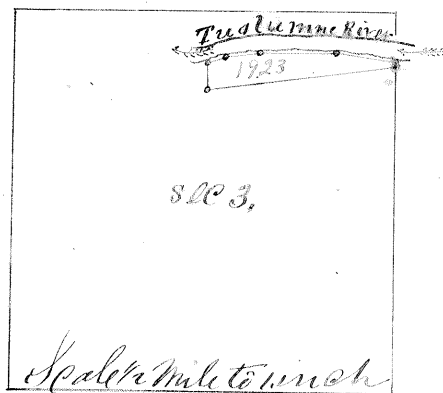
