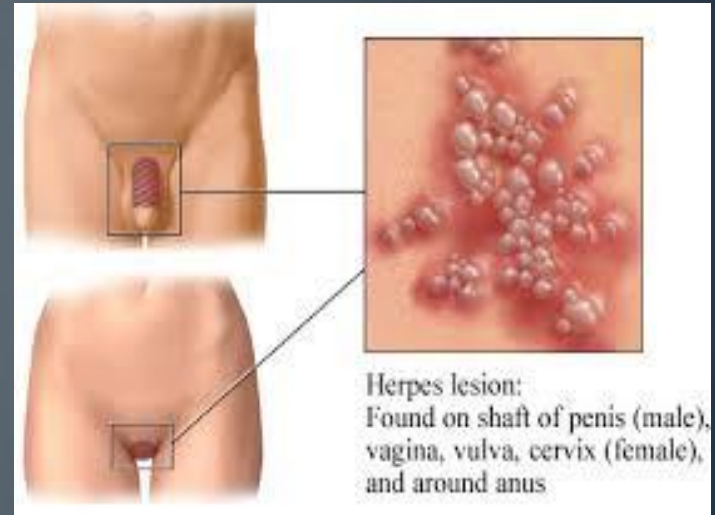


Types Of Herpes

Symptoms Of Herpes

Oral Herpes

- Oral herpes is an infection of the lips, mouth, or gums due to the herpes simplex virus. It causes small, painful [blisters](#) commonly called cold sores or fever blisters. Oral herpes is also called herpes Labialis.
- Itching of the lips or skin around mouth
- Burning near the lips or mouth area
- Tingling near the lips or mouth area

Genital Herpes

- Genital herpes virus is passed from one person to another through sexual contact.
- Cracked, raw, or red areas around your genitals without pain, [itching](#), or tingling
- [Itching](#) or tingling around your genitals or your anal region
- Small blisters that break open and cause painful sores. These may be on or around your genitals ([penis](#) or [vagina](#)) or on your buttocks, thighs, or rectal area. More rarely, blisters may occur inside the urethra -- the tube urine passes through on its way out of your body.
- Pain from urine passing over the sores -- this is especially a problem in women.
- Headaches, Backaches, flu – like symptoms

How Do People Get Infected With Herpes??

Herpes is transmitted through direct skin-to-skin contact. You can get herpes from touching someone else's skin that has herpes, including:

- Kissing someone with a cold sore
- Oral, anal and vaginal sex
- Touching any area infected with herpes

You can get herpes even if you can't see it. Genital herpes can be transmitted sexually both when a person has noticeable symptoms and when they don't.

Is there a cure for herpes?

- No, herpes can't be cured. Once the virus enters your body, you can't get rid of it. But there are to treat herpes that can lower the number of herpes outbreaks you have. Herpes is usually not harmful, but it can make it easier for you to receive HIV if you're exposed.

Can I still have sex if I have herpes?

- If you have herpes, you should tell your sex partner(s) and let him or her know that you do and the risk involved. Using condoms may help lower this risk but it will not get rid of the risk completely. Having sores or other symptoms of herpes can increase your risk of spreading the disease. Even if you do not have any symptoms, you can still infect your sex partners.

- A diagnosis of herpes often comes as a shock. Many people do not feel comfortable talking about sexuality and sexual health issues. There are many avenues for help, reassurance and guidance. Below are resources that can offer help and support for people living with and affected by herpes..
